

IMPACT STATEMENT

Legislation title: *Pay claim of Patricia O'Donovan in the sum of \$27,505 involving Water Bureau. (Ordinance)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This Ordinance settles a bodily injury claim brought by Patricia O'Donovan and her automobile insurer, Travelers Insurance, for injuries from an automobile collision.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue.

Total cost to the City to settle the claim is \$27,505.90. The City will reimburse Ms. O'Donovan's automobile insurer, Travelers Insurance, for the \$5,505.90 it paid for her medical treatment. The City will pay Patricia O'Donovan a total of \$22,000 (the City has advanced \$5,000 of this amount, so will pay her an additional \$17,000 under this Ordinance).

The source of funding is the City's Insurance and Claims Fund. All cost of the settlement is in the current fiscal year. This Ordinance does not amend the budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This Ordinance settles a tort claim resulting from an automobile collision involving a City driver. No public involvement or input was sought regarding this Ordinance. The City Attorney's Office and Risk Management have concluded that it is not appropriate to have public involvement in settlement negotiations regarding tort claims or lawsuits against the City.

No future public involvement is anticipated or necessary. Approval by City Council of this Ordinance will fully settle a tort claim against the City of Portland.
