

An Ordinance authorizing the approval, upon certain conditions, of options secured in connection with the extension of U. S. Highway W-99 (S. W. Front Avenue and other streets), and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that action should be taken without delay upon certain options which have been obtained in connection with the proposed extension along S. W. Front Avenue and certain other streets of U. S. Highway W-99, between S. W. Columbia Street and S. W. Barbur Boulevard, inasmuch as such options are about to expire; now, therefore, the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Works are hereby authorized, on behalf of the city, to execute certain documents, to be approved by the City Attorney as to form, notifying the respective optionors of the city's acceptance thereof, provided that no option shall be accepted for a larger amount than the amount stated in such option.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland, in this: That said street widening is needed at the earliest practicable date; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
