

An Ordinance providing for a police patrol box to be installed on a pole owned by the Portland Traction Company at the northwest corner of S.W. Taylor street and 5th avenue, authorizing the execution of a proper document relieving the Company of claims for injuries as the result of such box, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that the Bureau of Police requires, in order that better police service may be provided at and adjacent to the bus terminal, a police patrol box installation on a steel pole owned by the Portland Traction Company at the northwest corner of S.W. Taylor street and 5th avenue; that this company is willing to grant a permit for such installation provided that it, said company, be relieved of any claims for injuries which may be made against the company due to the presence of such box on said pole, and that the City should obtain such permission on the condition stated; now, therefore, the Mayor is hereby authorized on behalf of the City to execute a suitable document approved by the City Attorney as to form agreeing to relieve and protect said Company against any claim for injuries which may be made against it due to the presence of such police patrol box on said pole, and the Bureau of Police is hereby authorized upon receiving such permit from said Company to make and maintain said installation, all of which shall be done in a careful and workmanlike manner.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That the installation of said box is needed without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
