

ORDINANCE No. 187540

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County Sheriff's Office for fireboat refueling. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) currently has a Rescue Boat 17 (Boat) located on Hayden Island, on the Columbia River, on the northern edge of its jurisdiction.
2. PF&R currently fuels the Boat at a commercial marina approximately 25 minutes away, and outside their fire management area, on the Willamette River.
3. The Multnomah County Sheriff's Office River Patrol Unit (MCSO) has a fueling station for their boats located 10 minutes upriver, on the Columbia River, and within the Boat's fire management area.
4. MCSO is willing to allow PF&R to refuel at its fueling station for the actual cost it pays for fuel.
5. PF&R's is willing to pay said costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute an agreement in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit A, with Multnomah County Sheriff's Office.


