## ORDINANCE No. 187542

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for construction of the I-5 SB: Broadway-Weidler Exit Ramp project for an estimated \$166,803 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The I-5 freeway and its on/off ramps are part of the state highway system under the
  jurisdiction and control of the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT). N. Broadway,
  N. Weidler Street and N. Vancouver Avenue are part of the City of Portland Bureau of
  Transportation (PBOT) street system.
- 2. ODOT is constructing improvements to the I-5 SB from N. Broadway N.Weidler Street exit ramp. These improvements will include realignment of the right turn lane slip lane on the southbound ramp at N. Broadway N.Weidler Street and upgrading the traffic signal at the intersection of N. Broadway and N. Vancouver.
- 3. PBOT wants to construct a new traffic signal, sidewalks, striping and signage on N. Broadway between N. Ross Ave and N. Wheeler Ave.
- 4. PBOT wants ODOT to perform this work at PBOT's expense given the proximity of the two projects and the potential cost savings to be realized by constructing the two projects concurrently.
- 5. ODOT will invoice PBOT for the costs of building this work. PBOT will reimburse ODOT for the final costs of this work. These costs are included in the FY 15-16 budget.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate. The cost estimate for construction was developed during the design phase. The project has been awarded and is ready to start construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement, approved as to form by the City Attorney, with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the construction of the I-5 SB: Broadway-Weidler Exit Ramp project, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
