#### Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this legislation is to authorize a grant application to the Department of Homeland Security, through its Federal Emergency Management Agency for a grant to pay for operations level structural collapse training for all truck companies.

- If PF&R receives this grant it will provide much needed operations level structural collapse training for all truck companies using equipment that is already present on the PF&R trucks.
