Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance will close OMF Risk Management file Number 2015-002089-20, which arises from injuries sustained by Jerry Manns in a road hazard incident that occurred on April 8, 2015 at NE Sandy near NE 55th Avenue.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue.

Cost to the City is \$10,000.00. The source of funding is the City's Insurance and Claims Fund. All cost of the settlement is in the current fiscal year. This Ordinance does not amend the budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This Ordinance settles a tort claim resulting from a road hazard incident involving Jerry Manns and the Portland Bureau of Transportation in NE Portland. Jerry Manns suffered injuries as a result.

No public involvement or input was sought regarding the Ordinance. The City Attorney's Office and Risk Management have concluded that it is not appropriate to have public involvement in settlement negotiations regarding tort claims or lawsuits against the City.
