Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Office of the State Fire Marshal (OSFM) has notified the City that it will award a subgrant for the 2015 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant (HMEP 2015) to Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) in the amount of \$48,672.

- The OSFM project will fund a Flammable Liquids Bulk Storage Specialty Training course for PF&R's Fire Station 24 personnel. This training will provide much needed advanced training for the PF&R specialty team primarily responsible for handling transportation accidents and incidents.
- This training supports the City's Emergency Preparedness policies.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This legislation will appropriate \$48,672 to PF&R's grant fund to cover the expenses associated with the training. The required match will be in-kind contribution of salary and benefits for the firefighters attending training.
