

ORDINANCE NO. 78693

An Ordinance granting a leave of absence to Harold L. Seely, Bureau of Fire, Department of Public Safety, of the City for service in the military forces of the United States, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the "War Code", Article 5 as amended, and the approved application of Harold L. Seely for leave of absence from the Bureau of Fire on account of entering the military service of the United States, said application is hereby granted and said Harold L. Seely is hereby granted a leave of absence effective May 2, 1943 under the terms and conditions of said code.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That the present necessities of war requires additional men without delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
