

ORDINANCE NO. 79233

An Ordinance granting a leave of absence to Robert B. Root, Bureau of Police, Department of Public Safety of the City for service in the armed forces of the United States, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the "War Code", Article 5 as amended, and the approved application of Robert B. Root for leave of absence from the Bureau of Police on account of entering the armed forces of the United States, said application is hereby granted and said Robert B. Root is hereby granted a leave of absence effective October 8, 1943, under the terms and conditions of said code.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland, in this: That the present necessities of war require additional men without delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
