Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division has notified the City that it will award a grant for the 2016 Speed Enforcement Grant Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$12,000.

Portland Police Bureau officers and sergeants will be reimbursed at their actual overtime rate for overtime worked on speed enforcement at top speed involved crash locations within the City as determined by the ODOT Transportation Safety Division.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The total grant award is \$12,000, which will be divvied between FY2016 and FY2017. At this time, the City will appropriate \$9,000 into the Grant Fund for FY2016 and \$3,000 for FY2017. This grant comes with a straight-time match obligation of \$3,000 which will be funded by the Police Bureau's General Fund appropriation.
