Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for construction of the Tabor Sewer Rehabilitation Project Phase 1 No. E10712 for \$6,000,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Approximately 17,300 feet of combined sewer pipe in the Tabor and North Tabor neighborhoods, between of Interstate 84, SE Stark St, SE 44th Ave, and SE 66th Ave is in severely deteriorated condition and needs to be replaced or rehabilitated.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$6,000,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2015, 2016, and 2017 Budgets, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10712.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
