TO THE COUNCIL:

On December 16, 2015, Council approved Ordinance Number 187518 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant Stormwater Pump Station 2 – West in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Invitation to Bid Number 00000146 on behalf of the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES), with a project construction estimate of \$880,700. BES rated the project estimate confidence level as High.

Bids were opened on November 12, 2016, and four (4) bids were received. The low bid of Stellar J Corporation was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Stellar J Corporation's bid be accepted at the estimated lump sum quoted for a total bid amount of \$615,000.00.

BES along with Procurement Services, identified two (2) Divisions of Work as potential subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$269,702.72 awarded to subcontractors.

In their bid, Stellar J Corporation indicated their intent to self-perform the following Divisions of Work:

MWESB participation represents 6.2% or \$16,700.00 of the estimated subcontracting dollars.

- MBE \$2,700 performing Concrete Cutting.
- WBE \$14,000 performing Hauling Services (Trucking).

Stellar J Corporation is located in Woodland, Washington, and is not a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center WBS E10726.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each in the amount of 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
