EXTENSION AGREEMENT

It is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that their certain agreement executed on the 20th day of August, 1942, and providing for the use by Oregon Shipbuilding Corporation of the incinerator facilities and fill owned and operated by the City of Portland for the purpose of disposing of waste materials and debris, be and the same is hereby extended for an additional two-year period commencing June 1, 1944. This agreement may be cancelled by either party by the giving of fifteen days prior written notice to the other of its intent to cancel.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties have duly executed this agreement in twenty signed originals as of this _____ day of November, 1944.

ORDINANCE NO. 80561

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities to execute an agreement between the City and the Oregon Shipbuilding Corporation extending for an additional two year period an agreement providing for the use by said Corporation of certain incinerator and fill facilities; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that the agreement entered into August 20, 1942, between the City and the Oregon Shipbuilding Corporation for the use of certain incinerator and fill facilities, has expired, that said Corporation has applied for a renewal thereof for an additional period of two years from and after June 1, 1944, and that it is to the mutual interest of the City and of said Corporation that such extension be effected; now, therefore, the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City an extension agreement providing for the use by the said Oregon Shipbuilding Corporation of the incinerator facilities and fill operated by the City in connection with the St. Johns fill, for an additional two year period to commence June 1, 1944, said extension agreement to be substantially as provided in copy of agreement attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and by reference made a part hereof. There shall be executed twenty originals of said extension agreement, the same to be approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland, in this: In order that arrangements between the City and said Corporation as stated in Section 1 hereof may proceed without interruption it is necessary that this ordinance become immediately effective; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
