

An Ordinance accepting certain easement for the construction of a sewer in Private Property on N. Gloucester Avenue, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described easement be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for sewer purposes:

A strip of land five (5.0) feet in width the center line being the line between Lots 11 and 12, block "F", Portsmouth Villa Extended, in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, from the east line of Block "F", to a line sixty-five (65.0) feet westerly. (Deeded by John Cresap, single)

Section 2. That the City Auditor be and he is hereby directed to have the easement for right of way described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record and a copy of said ordinance forwarded to the County Assessor.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that the easement be accepted at once so that proceedings in the matter of the construction of a sewer in private property on N. Gloucester Avenue may be carried forward without delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
