

ORDINANCE NO. 81134

AN ORDINANCE amending article 105 of the License and Business Code (Ordinance No. 76398) so as to provide certain additional regulations concerning antique dealers.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that insufficient regulation and control is now provided with reference to antique dealers; now, therefore, article 105 of the License and Business Code (Ordinance No. 76398) is hereby amended as herein provided.

Section 2. Section 20-10502 of said Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 20-10502. DEFINITIONS. The term "antiques" as here used shall include old furniture, old table ware, old cooking utensils, old bric-a-brac, old whatnots, old wearing apparel, and other things handled by such dealer which are advertised, represented or held out as being made for use not less than fifty years prior thereto.

The term "antique dealer" as here used shall include any person, firm or corporation who buys, sells, offers for sale or otherwise deals in antiques.


Section 3. Said ordinance is further amended by adding to said article two new sections which shall be numbered, entitled and read as follows:

Section 20-10504. ANTIQUE DEALERS TO FILE BOND. No license shall be issued to any person proposing to conduct an antique store or place of business until a surety company bond in the sum of \$1,000.00 shall have been duly executed and filed with the City Auditor or cash money deposited with the Auditor in said amount. Said bond or cash shall be on condition that any person doing business with such dealer shall have a right of action on said bond in the name of the City of Portland to recover fair and just damages resulting from any misrepresentation or unfair dealing in said business.


Section 20-10505. FURNISHING RECEIPTS. It shall be unlawful for any antique dealer to receive or accept on consignment any thing covered by this

article without giving to the consignor a receipt
or document serving as a receipt identifying the
article, its estimated value and terms of delivery.
