An Ordinance granting to the Portland General Electric Company, its successors and assigns, a revocable permit to construct and maintain over and along S.W. Canyon Road an 11,000 volt extension power line, providing the conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that the Portland General Electric Company has made application for a permit to install, operate and maintain an 11,000 volt power line along a portion of S.W. Canyon Road in order to install and maintain a new extension power line to take care of an increased load in the Sylvan area, and that such permit should be granted subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter named: Now, therefore, a revocable permit be and the same is hereby granted to Portland General Electric Company, hereinafter referred to as the grantee, to install, operate and maintain an 11,000 volt power line over and along a portion of the above named street as follows:

Starting on the existing pole line along the south side of S.W. Canyon Rd. at a point approximately 650 ft. east of the city limits and running to the city limits;

and to be located as shown on the attached sketch marked Exhibit "A", and made a part of this ordinance; Provided, that all pole structures, lines, equipment and appurtenances installed pursuant to this permit, shall be constructed, installed, maintained and operated in accordance with the existing specifications, rules and regulations set forth in the National Safety Code of the United States Bureau of Standards as said specifications, rules and regulations presently appear and as the same may be changed, altered or amended during the life of the permit hereby granted.

Section 2. The permit hereby granted is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council, and no expenditure of money hereunder, or lapse of time, or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the grantee, its successors and assigns, any vested or other right, or operate as an estoppel against the City. Upon revocation, the grantee, its successors or assigns, shall within thirty (30) days remove all poles, wires and/or other structures or things of whatever nature appurtenant thereto installed under this permit, and shall

leave the said street area in a safe and orderly condition, all to be done as directed by and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer.

Section 3. The permit hereby granted is for the use of the street area only, and shall not exempt the grantee from taking out any licenses or permits required by any existing ordinances for any operation, construction and/or maintenance carried on under the permit hereby granted, and this permit shall be authorization for the City Engineer to issue permits for the erection of poles or other installations in the street area, upon application by the grantee, accompanied by detailed plans for such construction.

Section 4. The grantee shall hold the City of Portland the City Engineer, and each and all of the officers and employees of said city free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property which may be occasioned by any construction, operation or maintenance carried on under the permit hereby granted.

Section 5. Within 30 days after the passage of this ordinance said grantee shall file with the City Auditor its written acceptance of this ordinance and of the terms and conditions herein expressed, in form to be approved by the City Attorney.

Section 6. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the privileges granted by this ordinance may be available to the grantee without undue delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
