### Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance applies for a grant from the Oregon Office of Emergency Management. The money will be used to improve the usability of the Collector application for rapid building assessments post disaster.

Previous testing of the Collector application has shown it is easy to use, quick to learn and provides accurate, easy to visualize information for planners and decision makers responding to a disaster. PBEM and many other City bureaus endorse Collector and its interface with WebEOC.
