

RESOLUTION No. **371 88**

Approve and terminate limited tax exemptions for properties under the Homebuyer Opportunity and Multiple-Unit Limited Tax Exemption Programs (Resolution)

WHEREAS, in 1991, the Oregon Legislature passed legislation allowing local jurisdictions to forgo a portion of property tax revenue for a defined period of time as an incentive for the development of housing that achieve larger City policy goals; and

WHEREAS, on behalf of the City of Portland, the Portland Housing Bureau administers the Homebuyer Opportunity and Multiple-Unit Limited Tax Exemption Programs, authorized under ORS 307 and Portland City Code 3.102 and 3.103; and

WHEREAS, ORS 307.624, 307.627, 307.674 and 307.687 and City Code Sections 3.102.050, 3.102.080, and 3.103.100 require Portland City Council to approve, deny, and terminate tax exemptions in the form of a resolution containing the property owner's name and address and a description of the property or the assessor's property account number; and

WHEREAS, the properties identified in Exhibit A meet the specific conditions upon which the approval, denial or termination of the application is based under ORS 307.624, 307.627, 307.674 and 307.687 and City Code Sections 3.102.050, 3.102.080, and 3.103.100; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council approves new tax exemption applications and terminates tax exemptions previously approved which are no longer in compliance with program requirements under the Homebuyer Opportunity and Transit Oriented Development (now known as the Multiple-Unit) Limited Tax Exemption Programs as are listed in the attached Exhibit A.
