SUBJECT: Accept report from Portland Community College on the current work of Future Connect

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I am pleased to submit for your consideration a report from Portland Community College on the current work of Future Connect.

Future Connect is in its fifth year of partnership with the City of Portland in concert with the PCC Foundation. Serving over 600 students since its launch, Future Connect is an innovative college scholarship and success program targeted at lower-income Portlanders from families with little or no experience having attended college. Participating students are provided with a scholarships based on financial need, a guided path through college, a college success coach and other one-on-one supports. City of Portland resources are matched with support from donors from the PCC Foundation to provide students access to college and the supports they need to thrive.

Future Connect students are making significant progress toward their educational and career goals. They have interned with the legislature, local government and business; studied abroad; become student government leaders; and earned scholarships to universities. Future Connect graduates are continuing their studies at Portland State, Pacific University, Lewis and Clark College, Oregon State University and Brigham Young University, among others. They are on track for careers in psychology, education, medicine, business, engineering, computer science, and others.


I hope that through this presentation, the council can further educate our community about the work of Portland Community College in providing pathways for high schools students to attend college and on-going support to students once enrolled.
