## TO THE COUNCIL:

The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services is responsible for the maintenance and replacement of all City-owned vehicles in order to provide for timely and efficient fulfillment of City employees work related transportation needs. At this time, a large portion of the current Police Bureau fleet is nearing the end of its expected life and as the vehicles "age out" they must be replaced in a timely fashion in order to minimize additional maintenance and repair costs for the aging vehicles.

On September 30, 2015, City Council passed Ordinance No. 187357 authorizing the purchase of approximately 70 new vehicles for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$2,329,151.

In accordance with City Code 5.33.140 the City may participate in Cooperative Procurements without further competition, in order to establish participating agreements for the acquisition of goods or services. The State of Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) issued competitive solicitation number DASPS 2052-14 which resulted in Contract #5551 for vehicle purchases effective April 6, 2015. This Agreement allows municipalities and other governmental agencies to utilize the agreement in order to purchase such vehicles as may be required for current operations. Funds for vehicle purchases as identified herein are available in the CityFleet Vehicle Replacement Fund.

As required by City Code 5.33.160, a Notice of Intent to Award a Contract was issued on January 29, 2016. No responses or protests were received. Awarding an agreement to Gresham Ford will allow CityFleet to continue to provide vehicles in a timely manner for the Portland Police Bureau. It is requested that City Council authorize a participating agreement with Gresham Ford in the amount of \$2,329,151.00.

Gresham Ford has a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration account, is in compliance with the City's Equal Benefits Program, and their EEO Certification is current. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is High.
