TO THE COUNCIL:

On October 28, 2015, Council approved Ordinance 187413 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Grant Pool Mechanical Renovation - Rebid Project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000195 on behalf of the Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R) with a project construction estimate of \$1,500,000.

Bids were opened on January 28, 2016, and two (2) bids were received. The first low bid from Hydro-Temp Mechanical, Inc. was non-responsive to the City's Good Faith Efforts and was rejected. The second low bid of 2KG Contractors, Inc. was responsive to the solicitation and Good Faith Efforts requirements, therefore it is recommended that 2KG Contractor's bid be accepted at the estimated lump sum price quoted for a total bid amount of \$1,744,000.

PP&R along with Procurement Services, identified ten (10) Divisions of Work as potential subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$1,275,701.00 awarded to subcontractors.

In their bid, 2KG Contractors, Inc. indicated their intent to self-perform the following Divisions of Work:

Site Work	Carpentry	Doors	Demolition	Fencing
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MWESB participation represents 7.2% or \$91,750.00 of the estimated subcontracting dollars.

MBE - \$91,750.00 performing Concrete Pumping and Concrete Work

Due to the very specialized nature of the work there were limited subcontracting opportunities for MWESB contractors on this particular project.

2KG Contractors, Inc. is located in Portland, OR, and is not a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under PP&R Owner Cost Center P30050.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
