\* Authorize the Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management to execute Intergovernmental Agreements and amendments for the administration of the FY 2015 Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant funds for all-hazards disaster preparedness (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Department of Homeland Security provides financial assistance to selected urban areas through their Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program. The City of Portland, in conjunction with regional partners (TriMet, Port of Portland, Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington and Columbia Counties of Oregon and Clark County, Washington), collaborating through the Regional Disaster Preparedness Organization, were granted financial assistance to address the region's unique equipment, training, planning, and exercise needs for allhazards disaster preparedness. The Portland Urban Area has completed a regional strategy and work plan to guide the use of federal homeland security grant funds. The City of Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) is the administrator of the grant for the region.
- 2. In support of UASI Grant administration, PBEM enters into routine Intergovernmental Agreements (IGAs) with our regional partners (TriMet, Port of Portland, Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington and Columbia Counties of Oregon and Clark County, Washington) to provide them with access to UASI grant funds.
- 3. The execution of routine Intergovernmental Agreements in support of Grant administration would be more efficiently performed if delegated to the Director of PBEM.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management of the City of Portland may execute Intergovernmental Agreements and amendments to these Intergovernmental agreements with TriMet, Port of Portland, Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington and Columbia Counties of Oregon and Clark County, Washington, related to UASI 2015, grant no.15-170.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
