## ORDINANCE No. 18760 C

\* Authorize Intergovernmental Agreements with the City of Canby, Oregon and the City of Tigard, Oregon for the use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance Federal Fiscal Year 2014 Intellectual Property Enforcement Program grant funds for agency personnel overtime and approved grant program expenses (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) awarded the City a grant for the FFY 14 Intellectual Property Enforcement Program (IPEP) in the amount of \$373,569;
- 2. Council authorized acceptance of the grant award on November 4, 2015;
- 3. The IPEP allows law enforcement programs to address, and the ability to prevent and prosecute intellectual property crimes;
- 4. A condition of the grant program requires the City to serve as lead applicant and fiscal agent for the participating municipalities. The City wishes to execute Intergovernmental Agreements with the cities of Canby and Tigard to obligate agency roles and responsibilities;
- 5. The City will, with DOJ OJP BJA grant funds, reimburse the cities of Canby and Tigard for the cost of all approved program expenses not to exceed \$156,176, divided between the City of Canby (\$55,325), the City of Tigard (\$100,851);
- 6. The agreements shall begin February 1, 2016, and extend through September 30, 2018, or until grant funds are exhausted; and
- 7. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the release of grant funds from DOJ.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute Intergovernmental Agreements in the forms similar to the agreements attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on c. behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by OJP for the FFY 14 Intellectual Property Enforcement Program Grant, #2015-BE-BX-0005, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Council.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this authorization would jeopardize the release of the grant funds from DOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
