Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This legislation authorizes Intergovernmental Agreements (IGAs) with the City of Canby, Oregon and the City of Tigard, Oregon. The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) awarded the City a grant for the FFY 14 Intellectual Property Enforcement Program (IPEP) in the amount of \$373,569. Council authorized acceptance of the grant award on November 4, 2015. The IGAs obligate agency roles and responsibilities for each participating agency for the duration of the grant program.

Financial and budgetary impacts: There are no financial or budgetary impacts with this legislation. Canby's grant award amount, \$55,325, and Tigard's grant award amount, \$100,851, will be appropriated in future BMPs.
