ORDINANCE NO.

*Authorize application to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Office of Community Planning and Development, Office of HIV/AIDS Housing for a grant in the approximate amount of \$700,000 to integrate HIV/AIDS housing services with services for survivors of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence and stalking (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has made available a Notice of Funding Availability for providing housing assistance and supportive services to low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS (PLWHA) who are homeless, or in need of transitional housing or other housing assistance, as a result of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, or stalking; and for whom emergency shelter services or other crisis intervention services are unavailable or insufficient.
- 2. The Portland Housing Bureau is responding to the Notice of Funding Availability with an application for approximately \$700,000 in federal funds, to be spent over three years.
- 3. No match is required by this grant.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant in the approximate amount of \$700,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the grant period.
- c. The Portland Housing Bureau, in collaboration with the Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division, is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grant must be submitted no later than March 8, 2016. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
