Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Oregon Impact has notified the Bureau that it will award a grant for the 2016 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement Mini-Grant Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$5,000.

Portland Police Bureau officers will be reimbursed for overtime worked on pedestrian safety enforcement operations.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The total grant award is \$5,000, which will be divvied between FY2016 and FY2017. At this time, the City will appropriate \$2,500 into the Grant Fund for FY2016 and \$2,500 for FY2017. This grant comes with a straight-time match obligation which will be funded by the Police Bureau's General Fund appropriation.
