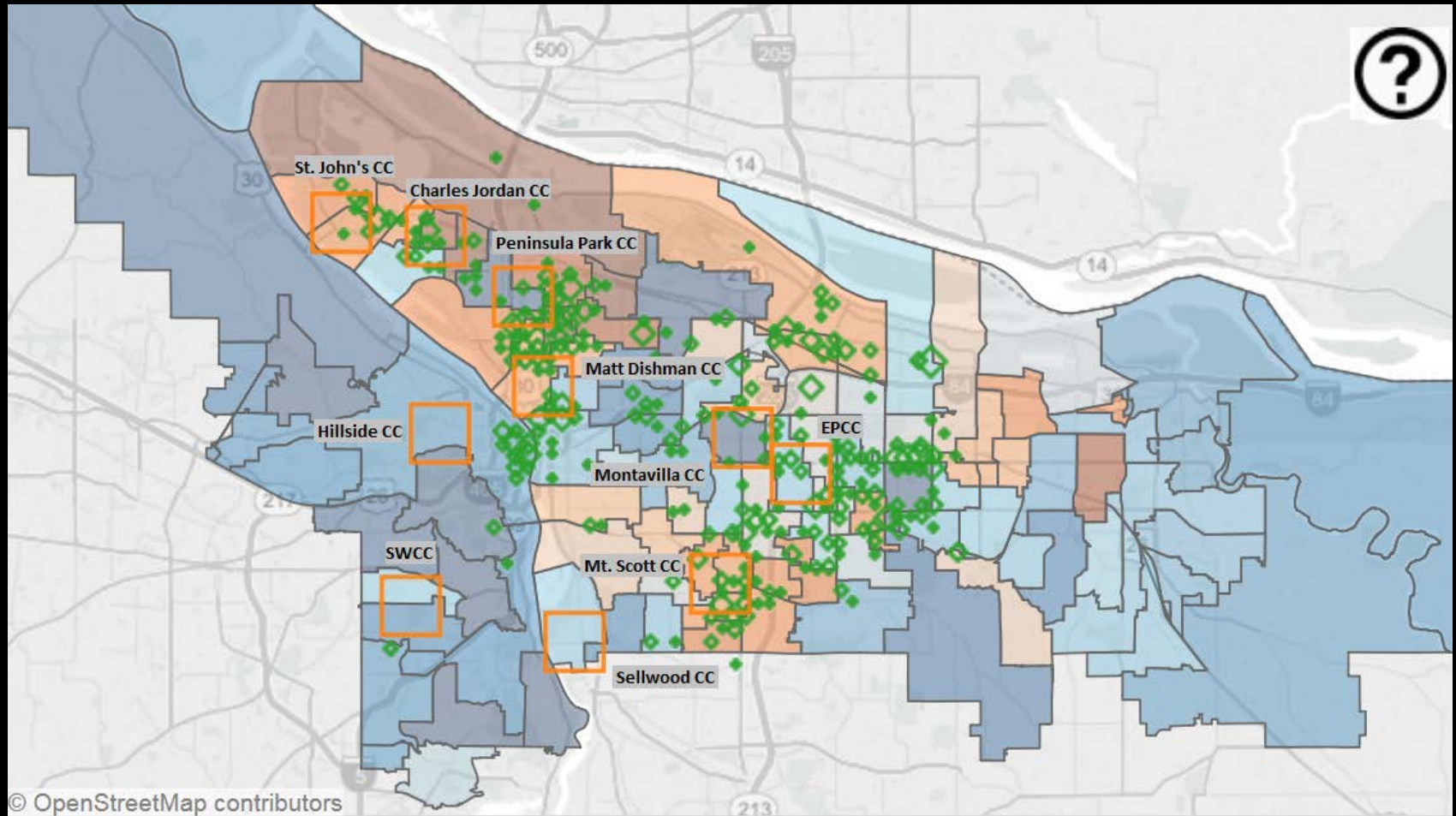

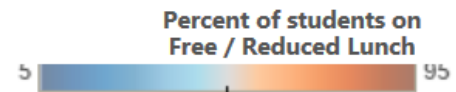
Record Year of Gang Violence

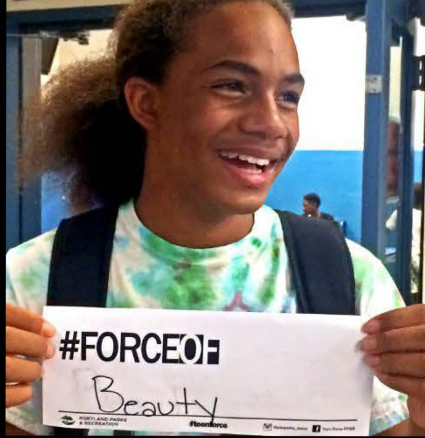

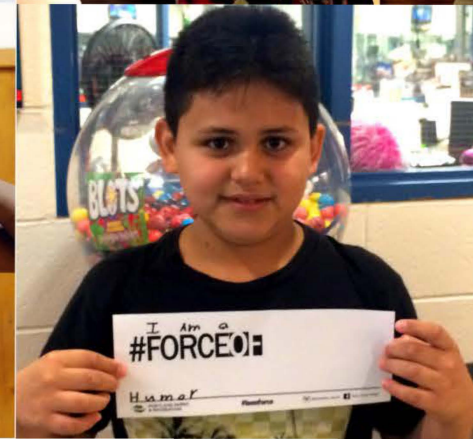
Summer Youth Pass: Matt Dishman CC
