

IMPACT STATEMENT

Legislation title: Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction replacement of the deficient bridge structure on NE Glisan St at NE 90th Ave. (Ordinance)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

PBOT proposes to reconstruct a 105 year old aged and worn bridge structure on NE Glisan Street at NE 90th avenue. The bridge was built over long abandoned railroad line. When the bridge is removed the void below the bridge will be infilled and a roadway will be built in its place. Thus in the future the City will have one less distressed and weight restricted bridge to maintain.

PBOT's two year action plan, Portland Progress, requires that PBOT replace one poor condition bridge per year. This replacement project will enable PBOT to achieve that goal.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The funds for this project were provided to PBOT by City Council in FY 2016 using surplus one time General Fund appropriations to replace aged transportation assets. The project funds have been budgeted in PBOT's FY 15-16 and 16-17 years.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This project replaces aged and distressed structures used daily by the community. By completing the structures replacements, we are ensuring mobility for future users.

We have designed the temporary traffic detour plan to ensure that all users, whether vehicular, bike or pedestrian, have access through the site for the entire project duration. That way the disruption to the public is minimal.

PBOT has collaborated with the Water Bureau to re-align an aged water line within Glisan Street while the project is under construction.

Construction work on the project will be carried out during the summer months while the nearby Columbia Christian School is on summer recess, minimizing disruption to the school children.

The project staff has communicated directly with the adjacent Central Bible Church, Eastside Church of Christ, and to Columbia Christian School to ensure they are aware of the project.

The project staff has also communicated with the Neighborhood associations to ensure that they are aware of the project.

The project staff has distributed informational flyers to residents & businesses affected by the project detour to ensure that they are aware of the project.
