## ORDINANCE No. 187631 As Amended

\*Authorize the Director of Transportation or designee to enter into and sign Non-Disclosure Agreements between the City and prospective vendors in order for City employees to review proprietary information (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. At certain times, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) may enter into negotiations on services, products, or technologies that are, or may be, considered for use by the PBOT.
- 2. In order to allow PBOT employees to review proprietary information PBOT may be required to enter into a non-disclosure agreement by the vendor.
- 3. Any non-disclosure agreement would be limited to the disclosure or release of proprietary or confidential information, whether held by the PBOT or the vendor, and does not include any monetary consideration.
- 4. All Non-disclosure agreements entered into by the bureau will be with the consent of the Commissioner-in-Charge of Transportation and approved by the City Attorney.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

That the Director of the Portland Bureau of Transportation or designee is hereby authorized a. to enter into non-disclosure agreements with the consent of the Commissioner-in-Charge by City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the need for non-disclosure agreements may arise at any time; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
