

**ORDINANCE No. 187631 As Amended**

\*Authorize the Director of Transportation or designee to enter into and sign Non-Disclosure Agreements between the City and prospective vendors in order for City employees to review proprietary information (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. At certain times, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) may enter into negotiations on services, products, or technologies that are, or may be, considered for use by the PBOT.
2. In order to allow PBOT employees to review proprietary information PBOT may be required to enter into a non-disclosure agreement by the vendor.
3. Any non-disclosure agreement would be limited to the disclosure or release of proprietary or confidential information, whether held by the PBOT or the vendor, and does not include any monetary consideration.
4. All Non-disclosure agreements entered into by the bureau will be with the consent of the Commissioner-in-Charge of Transportation and approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Director of the Portland Bureau of Transportation or designee is hereby authorized to enter into non-disclosure agreements with the consent of the Commissioner-in-Charge by City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the need for non-disclosure agreements may arise at any time; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


