Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Prior to the 2000-2001 transition to the Colt M4 carbine, the HK MP5 was the SERT primary entry shoulder weapon. Since this transition, the MP5 inventory has been maintained, but not used. SERT currently has an inventory of 18 MP5s. Various avenues have been explored to dispose of this weapon system to remove them from the inventory, while generating revenue for essential SERT items. The Washington County Sheriff's Office is interested in six of the 18 MP5s and is willing to pay \$850 each. \$850 is the value of the weapons if sold for parts.

City Code Subsection 5.36.010 F requires Council approval for the disposition of surplus firearms.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The sale of six MP5s to the Washington County Sheriff's Office will generate \$5,100 in revenue for the Training Division Firearms Trust Account to be dispersed for SERT equipment.

Community impacts and community involvement:

None, this legislation impact internal operations by removing unnecessary weapons from inventory and maintenance while generating revenue for needed items.
