

## ORDINANCE No. 94113

An Ordinance authorizing the Commissioner of Public Works and Auditor to draw a warrant on the Sewage Disposal Fund in payment to Ray Carlton Carrithers and Frances B. Carrithers and Carlton B. Gorsch and Jayne B. Gorsch for certain right-of-way for the interceptor of the Portland Sewage Disposal System, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that the City Engineer has, in accordance with Ordinance No. 82364, arranged for a certain right-of-way for the interceptor of the Portland Sewage disposal Project, location being Lot 13, Block 4, Cook's Second Addition to Albina; that \$18.00 is a fair amount to be paid under the circumstances; that payment should be made and a deed for said right-of-way secured; now therefore the Commissioner of Public Works and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to draw and deliver a warrant in favor of Ray Carlton Carrithers and Frances B. Carrithers and Carlton B. Gorsch and Jayne B. Gorsch in the amount of \$18.00, following examination of title reports as to said property and approval thereof by the City Attorney. Said warrant shall be chargeable to the Sewage Disposal Fund 6350.680.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: in order that the construction of the Sewage Disposal Project shall go forward without delay it is necessary that the right-of-way herein described be secured as soon as possible; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
