

ORDINANCE No. 94380

An ordinance accepting a sewer easement through Lot 4, Block 30, Council Crest Park, Tract A, granted by John A. Irwin and Dorothy E. Irwin, husband and wife, for the 30 Sunset Blvd. and 30 Rosch Road sewer system, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described easement granted for the 30 Sunset Blvd. and 30 Rosch Road sewer system, be and is hereby accepted for sewer purposes.

A portion of Lot 4, Block 30, Council Crest Park, Tract A, being a strip of land 5.0 feet in width, 2.5 feet on either side of the following described center line:

Beginning at a point in the northeasterly line of Lot 4, Block 30, Council Crest Park, Tract A, 2.5 feet easterly of the most northerly corner of said Lot 4; thence southwesterly, parallel to, and 2.5 feet distant from the northwesterly line of said Lot 4 to a point in the southwesterly line of said Lot 4, being in the corporate limits of the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon.

(Granted by John A. Irwin and Dorothy E. Irwin, husband and wife, 4341 S. Chesapeake Ave., \$50.00 being the amount to be paid for said easement.)

Section 2. That the City Auditor be and he is hereby directed to have this easement, as described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record, and a copy of said ordinance forwarded to the County Assessor.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: To avoid any unnecessary delay in making this right-of-way a matter of record; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
