

ORDINANCE No. 95804

An Ordinance accepting a sewer easement granted by Moore Dry Kiln Company of Oregon for the Interceptor of the Portland Sewage Disposal Project, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described easement granted for the Interceptor of the Portland Sewage Disposal Project, be and is hereby accepted for sewer purposes for the Portland Sewage Disposal Project:

A tract of land in Section 32, T. 2 N, R. 1 E, W.M. County of Multnomah.

Section 2. That the City Auditor be and he is hereby directed to have the easement as described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record and a copy of said ordinance forwarded to the County Assessor.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this; to avoid any unnecessary delay in making this easement a matter of record; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
