

## ORDINANCE No. 96140

An Ordinance granting a leave of absence for six months, without pay, to Thora C. Bundy, Bureau of Police, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that Thora C. Bundy, an employe in the Bureau of Police, has filed a request, under oath, for a leave of absence on account of illness, without pay, from noon on April 4, 1952, to October 4, 1952, in order that she may have the rest prescribed by her physician; that her request is supported by a statement from Claude A. Lewis, M. D., Medical Arts Building, Portland 5, Oregon, and the request is also approved by Donald I. McNamara, Chief of Police; now, therefore, a leave of absence without pay hereby is granted to Thora C. Bundy, Bureau of Police, for six months, effective from noon, April 4, 1952, to October 4, 1952.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that necessary arrangements may be made for temporary replacement, therefore an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
