

ORDINANCE No. 98426

An Ordinance accepting a sewer easement through Tax Lot 9, Section 20, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W.M., granted by Wayne Robert Miller and Florence Irene Miller, for the S.W. Multnomah Boulevard Storm and Sanitary Trunk Sewer Systems, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described easement granted for the S.W. Multnomah Boulevard Storm and Sanitary Trunk Sewer Systems be and is hereby accepted for sewer purposes:

The south 10 feet of the west 161 feet of that certain tract of land conveyed to Wayne Robert Miller and Florence Irene Miller, husband and wife, by deed recorded in Book 1230 at Page 206, Multnomah County P.S. deed records for 1947, and known as Tax Lot 9, Section 20, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W.M., being within the corporate limits of the City of Portland, County of Multnomah and State of Oregon.

(Granted by Wayne Robert Miller and wife, 7330 S.W. 53rd Avenue, \$80.50 being the amount to be paid for said easement.)

Section 2. That the City Auditor be and he is hereby directed to have this easement, as described in Section 1 of this ordinance, placed on record and a copy of said ordinance forwarded to the County Assessor.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: To avoid any delay in making this right-of-way a matter of record; therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
