Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The City has authorized IGAs with PSU for years to administer and implement the Portland Event Recycling Program. The Program provides essential loaner equipment, technical support and educational resources to ensure that Portland residents and visitors have the opportunity to recycle and, as appropriate, compost food scraps at large, medium and small public events throughout the City. The Ordinance authorizes the IGA for 2016-2019.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This ordinance authorizes an IGA with Portland State University for 2016-2019 in the amount of \$162,171.

The established cost is \$162,171. Funds in the current year are available in the Solid Waste Management Fund, FY 2015-16 budget, Bureau of Planning and Sustainability. Funds will be requested for the remainder of the Agreement and included in the FY 2016-17, FY 2017-18 and FY 2018-19 Bureau of Planning and Sustainability budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The purpose of the IGA is to support event coordinators through providing direct technical assistance, how to materials, instructional signage and easy access to recycling (and food scrap) collection container equipment. Providing Portlanders and visitors with the opportunity to recycle at an event is a public benefit that helps to increase the City's overall waste recovery rate, enhance livability and build a sense of goodwill and community.
