

ORDINANCE No. 187651

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon, Office of the State Fire Marshal for Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team Services. (Ordinance; Contract No. 30004993)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) participates in a regional hazardous materials emergency response team within the boundaries of the Emergency Response Area, when requested by the State Fire Marshal (OFM).
2. It is necessary that the agreement between the OFM and the City be updated and executed as soon as possible, substantially on the terms and conditions outlined in Exhibit A, attached hereto.
3. The Fire Chief recommends that the City execute this Agreement, and states that participation on the Regional Hazardous Materials Team will not impair the ability of PF&R to protect the citizens of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


