Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon, Office of the State Fire Marshal for Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team Services. (Ordinance; Contract No. 30004993)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) participates in a regional hazardous materials emergency response team within the boundaries of the Emergency Response Area, when requested by the State Fire Marshal (OFM).
- 2. It is necessary that the agreement between the OFM and the City be updated and executed as soon as possible, substantially on the terms and conditions outlined in Exhibit A, attached hereto.
- 3. The Fire Chief recommends that the City execute this Agreement, and states that participation on the Regional Hazardous Materials Team will not impair the ability of PF&R to protect the citizens of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and the City Auditor are authorized to execute this Intergovernmental Agreement for Regional Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Team Services for participation by Portland Fire & Rescue for biennium 2015-2017, substantially in accordance with Exhibit A, attached hereto.
