## Ordinance No.

\*Amend the FY 2015-2016 appropriation schedule in the amount of \$2,005,000 in order to retire the 2007 Series B Limited Tax Revenue Bond (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City issued its Limited Tax Revenue Bonds, 2007 Series B (Portland Mall Revitalization Project) (the "Bonds") in August 2007, of which \$3,935,000 is outstanding.
- 2. The City can achieve approximately \$60,000 in interest cost savings by prepaying, at the earliest possible redemption date, the outstanding principal and accrued interest on the Bonds.
- 3. The City is required to provide notice to its paying agent approximately 35 days prior to the date that Bonds are redeemed.
- 4. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) has funds currently available that could be used to redeem the Bonds, but applying funds toward repayment of a portion of the Bonds would require an amendment to the budget.
- 5. Amending the budget now allows the City to redeem all of the outstanding Bonds and achieve interest cost savings.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The FY 2015/2016 budget is hereby amended as follows:

Fund: 200

Business Area: TR

Debt Service: \$2,005,000

Contingency: (\$2,005,000)

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the time requirements for prepaying the Bonds and achieving interest savings; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
