Whereas, the Portland Housing Bureau is working with landlords and tenants to increase choice for low-income renters citywide; and

Whereas, under federal fair housing laws, Oregon civil rights statutes, and Portland city code, it is

*Thereas*, the Fair Housing Act Amendments banned discrimination against families with children and people with physical or mental disabilities and strengthened enforcement of the law;
