## ORDINANCE No. 187672

Authorize a no-cost Permit and Right of Entry agreement with the Port of Portland to grant City staff access to three Port sites to conduct environmental monitoring (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Area Watershed Monitoring and Assessment Program (PAWMAP) supports the implementation of the Portland Watershed Management Plan and allows BES to use the best available science in planning, prioritizing, designing, constructing and adaptively managing surface water projects and supports compliance with state and federal regulations including the Clean Water Act, and Endangered Species Act.
- 2. PAWMAP randomly selects sites to conduct field work to quantitatively assess and survey water quality, hydrology, physical habitat, and the diversity and health of fish, birds and other wildlife communities within Portland's watersheds.
- 3. Three randomly-selected monitoring sites are on Port of Portland property and require a *Permit and Right of Entry* agreement between the City of Portland and the Port of Portland.
- 4. Shown in the attached Exhibit A, the no-cost agreement grants City staff access to three sites on Port property for the purpose of collecting data and conducting an array of habitat assessments to support the City's watershed monitoring program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Commissioner-in-Charge of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute, renew, and amend Right of Entry agreements with the Port of Portland in general conformance with the attached Exhibit A for the purpose described in Section 1.
