ORDINANCE No. 187678

Amend Code Removing Barriers to Employment to clarify the exemption of volunteers (Ordinance; amend Code Section 23.10.020)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland City Council approved the creation of City Code Chapter 23.10 Removing Barriers to Employment, establishing required procedures for the use of criminal history information by employers within the City of Portland.
- 2. Since its approval, City Attorneys have been drafting the Administrative Rules governing the implementation of this Code, in preparation of bringing them before Council for adoption.
- 3. In drafting the Administrative Rules, a contradiction was noticed, in that the definition for "Employ" includes "with or without pay", even though volunteers are listed as exempt.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

a. That City Code Section 23.10.020 is amended as shown on the attached Exhibit A.
