## ORDINANCE No. 187682 As Amended

\*Amend contract with EcoNorthwest for additional implementation work for the Local Transportation Infrastructure Charge project Phase III (Ordinance; amend contract 30004500)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On March 4, 2015, through Ordinance No. 187038 City Council unanimously approved a contract for EcoNorthwest to establish a Local Transportation Infrastructure Charge.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT), EcoNorthwest, and a stakeholder committee of community members, City staff, and development and real estate businesses began a year long process to address the issue of infill development on unimproved streets within the City.
- 3. During the process, PBOT found a number of issues that did not necessarily have to be addressed to establish the charge but needed to be addressed to create a framework for allocating revenue from the charge, to determine project selection, to determine design standards, and to determine overall project financing.
- 4. Upon the successful establishment of the Local Transportation Infrastructure Charge, PBOT has agreed to collect the revenue but not allocate the revenue until these large issues are resolved.
- 5. PBOT also seeks to have a robust outreach program to seek input from residents on unimproved streets, neighborhoods, and diverse income and minority communities.
- 6. PBOT has negotiated a contract amendment with EcoNorthwest to continue this work and address the issues highlighted in the first phases of the project in the amount of \$340,000.
- 7. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high because the amendment has been negotiated and adequate contingencies have been built into each task item.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute the contract in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because PBOT wishes to begin work as soon as practicable and the community is eager to resolve these issues; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
