TO THE COUNCIL:

On December 2, 2015, Council approved Ordinance Number 187481 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the Colwood Golf Course - Phase II Redevelopment in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000204 on behalf of the Bureau of Parks & Recreation (PPR), with a project construction estimate of \$2,000,000. PPR rated the project estimate confidence level as Medium to High.

Bids were opened on March 10, 2016, and five (5) bids were received. The low bid from Moore Excavation, Inc was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Moore Excavation, Inc bid be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$1,945,819.00.

PPR, along with Procurement Services, identified five (5) Divisions of Work as potential subcontracting opportunities for this project, resulting in \$928,930.34 awarded to subcontractors.

The Divisions of Work identified were:

In their bid, Moore Excavation, Inc indicated their intent to self-perform the following Divisions of Work:

MWESB participation represents 29.73% or \$276,159.34 of the estimated subcontracting dollars.

- MBE \$268,059.34 performing Landscaping, Traffic Sign Installation/Removal and Drilling/Boring.
- WBE \$8,100 performing Surveying.

Moore Excavation, Inc is located in Fairview, Oregon, and is not a State Certified M/W/ESB Contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO

Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center P10462.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
