ORDINANCE NO.

* Authorize a competitive solicitation for Mobile Data Computer replacement laptops for the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Police Bureau (bureau) has determined that the approximately 350 in-car mobile data computers (MDCs) are aging and need to be replaced.
2. There is an immediate need to purchase replacement MDCs so as to change out the computers in a timely manner.
3. MDCs allow sworn staff to perform all administrative, communication, investigatory, and operations duties possible with technology while in their patrol districts; sworn members do not have to return to the office to perform these job functions.
4. The bureau is currently drafting a Request for Information to develop the specs for a Request for Proposal.
5. The bureau wishes to issue a solicitation for MDC replacements. The total estimated cost is approximately \$2,000,000.
6. Funding will be from the \$341,616 remaining in the MDC replacement fund and the bureau's General Fund appropriation.
7. City Code Section 5.33.040 A 5 requires that Council approve the award of Goods and Services Contracts in excess of \$500,000 prior to solicitation.
8. Time is of the essence to begin the solicitation process so that a contract can be executed by September, 2016. For this reason it is in the interest of the City that this be an emergency Ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with Portland City Code 5.33 in order to obtain the most responsible and responsive offers providing contracts for the provision of Mobile Data Computer replacement laptops at an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because undue delay may result in the City being unable to complete the solicitation before September 2016. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
