Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The proposed legislation is to allow the City of Portland Bureau of Parks & Recreation to enter into a PTE agreement with Opsis Architecture LLP to develop design plans for construction of maintenance facility improvements at Mt. Tabor and Urban Forestry Delta Park Maintenance Yards and a bicycle/pedestrian path adjacent to Mt. Tabor Yard.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The City expenses for consulting services are \$799,768, and costs will be incurred during FY 2016, FY 2016-FY 2017, FY 2017-2018, and FY 2018-2019. The funds for the maintenance facility improvements at Mt. Tabor and Delta Park are from the 2014 Replacement Bond and the bicycle/pedestrian path at Mt. Tabor is funded by System Development Charge fees.

The consultant services in this contract does not include preparation of Type III Conditional Use reviews, Right of Way Permits, traffic analyses or environmental reviews. Because of the uncertainty of the land use requirements, a contingency of \$180,000 is built in to this request. If required, a contract amendment for the additional services would result.

Community impacts and community involvement:

During design development, key stakeholders, user groups, and the general public will be consulted through meetings, open houses, online notification tools, and outreach at each site and various events.
