ORDINANCE No. 108597


An Ordinance authorizing payment of a judgment in condemnation in the case of City of Portland versus Hugo Paul, Circuit Court No. 244660, in the sum of \$10,000 with interest thereon, authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that proceedings for the acquisition of Tax Lot 26, Sec. 30, T1N, R1E, W.M., Multnomah County, for use as park property were commenced by the City in the condemnation case of City of Portland v. Hugo Paul, Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Multnomah, No. 244660; that in the trial of said case, defendant obtained a judgment dated July 3, 1958 for the sum of \$10,000 with interest thereon at the rate of 6% per annum from the 3rd day of July, 1958 until paid; that payment of certain costs and appraisers' fees connected with this same case was authorized by Ordinance No. 108503, passed by the Council August 13, 1958; that it is in the public interest to appropriate the above described property by payment of the sum of \$10,000 with accrued interest, pursuant to the judgment of the court; and it further appearing that the City Attorney and Commissioner in charge of the Bureau of Parks have recommended payment of said judgment; now, therefore, the Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant in the sum of \$10,000 together with interest at the rate of 6% per annum from the 3rd day of July, 1958, until date of payment, payable to Si Cohn, County Clerk for Multnomah County, Oregon, said warrant to be drawn against and charged to the appropriation Public Recreational Area Fund, Purchase of Land (5600.780).

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That immediate payment is necessary to comply with time limitations contained in a court judgment; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.




