ORDINANCE No. 187707

Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for design of the Pedestrian Crossing at 4 Schools project (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30003588)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On July 25, 2007, Council passed Ordinance No. 181167 that authorized the Portland Bureau of Transportation to submit two applications to receive grant funding through Safer Routes to School Program, administered by the Oregon Department of Transportation.
- 2. On October 12, 2012, the Oregon Department of Transportation awarded the Portland Bureau of Transportation a Safer Routes to School grant to fund bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements at four Portland public elementary schools.
- 3. The grant covered the total anticipated cost for engineering and construction of the project, estimated at approximately \$455,828.00
- 4. Amendment #1 will provide additional funds up to \$636,700.00 and will also extend the milestones again due to a delay in construction close out.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high. The project is now complete and ready to close out.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an amendment, approved as to form by the City Attorney, with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the design of the Pedestrian Crossing at 4 Schools project, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.


